

Volunteering With Us

The role of the Avenue Club Volunteer is to provide a friendly, welcoming and helpful environment, to offer advice and practical assistance as required to everyone visiting the Centre. A key aspect to this role will be to assist with events, such as coffee mornings, and meeting and greeting new and regular members.

Running such a range of activities requires significant organisational input so we are also looking for volunteers to help us with administration.

We are continually revisiting and expanding the services we offer, and we are always open to suggestions. If you have ideas and would like to set up a new activity, such as a book club, or anything else, please do let us know.

Catering Volunteers

We offer lunch to Avenue Club members on Monday and Wednesdays between 1200 and 1330. This role would involve working with a small team in the kitchen to both cook and serve light lunches and refreshments.

Gardening Volunteers

We are hoping to establish a small vegetable garden at the Centre. This role would require no more than an hour a week working alongside Members to create a useful and pleasant outdoor space.

Notice Board Volunteers

This role involves keeping our various notice boards up to date and looking eye catching. A role requiring a few hours a month and an opportunity to be creative.

Administrative Volunteers

We have two busy offices within the Centre and would welcome administrative support. A basic knowledge of IT would be useful but not essential.
